Michael Buckley heads University of Texas at Arlington's Center for Metropolitan Density, UTA's new urban think-tank researching urbanization, strategic industry clusters, demographic shifts, and high density workplace and residential formats. He recently served as Chair of Fort Worth Inc.'s Plan 2023 Educational Commission, generating cultural/educational initiatives in support of the future workforce. Buckley is a former President, Connecticut Society of Architects, and Board Member AIA Dallas. Guest University lectures have included MIT, Rice University, Yale, and University of Miami. Prof. Buckley is the former fifteen-year Director of Columbia University's Masters in Real Estate Development responsible for its innovative curriculum and growth to 100 Graduate students, recognized as one of the most progressive development-oriented of the Ivy-League programs. He is a founding member of the Real Estate Roundtable's Research Committee, and former Board Member of the Association of Foreign Investors in Real Estate.
